

Electrical Service for Food Vendors

(Please note must accompany your application for consideration)

The first 20 amp/120 V circuit of electricity is included in the vendor fee. Any additional electrical service carries an addition fee based on the type and amount. Additional needs or requests for electricity beyond this base must be included in the application.

If selected, you will be responsible for providing your own power cords and power distribution from the service connection to and within your vendor space. The National Electrical Code requires that all circuits provided by the Festival be equipped with a ground fault interrupt. You will be responsible for insuring that your equipment and power cables are compatible with ground fault interrupt circuits.
